



Dress Code Policy 2020-2021

Rationale:

- To establish a unique identity for St. Peter's School.
- To create a feeling of pride and self-esteem.
- To have a positive effect on study habits, academic performance, and behavior.
- To stimulate unity and school spirit.
- To eliminate problems of clothing selection at home and interpretation of appropriateness by the school.
- To eliminate competition in dress.

General Guidelines:

- All shirts must be neatly and completely tucked in and buttoned appropriately, unless wearing banded polo shirts.
- Hair should be a natural color, clean, and neatly groomed. No extreme hairstyles or facial hair will be permitted. No makeup.
- Head coverings, hats, sweatbands, wristbands, or similar articles may not be worn during school hours. No headbands that stick up above the hairline (i.e. cat ear headbands) and headbands must match one of the uniform colors.
- Outside jackets, coats, and sweatshirts may not be worn in the building during school hours.
- Students may be excused from adhering to the dress code for legitimate medical reasons with a parent conversation with principal.
- Dress code citations will be issued periodically in homeroom. Students in grades 4-6 will be given one notice of violation per quarter and then serve an after school detention. Parents are asked to be responsible to see that students come to school in the complete correct uniform.
- The dates to wear shorts is the first day of school thru October 15 and April 15 thru last day of school.
- **Final decisions with regard to uniform policy will be made by the principal.**

Shirts:

- K-6 - white, light blue or navy blue short-or long-sleeved polo shirt may be worn with pants, jumper, or shorts.
- K-6 - white, light blue or navy blue short-or long-sleeved oxford button-up shirt.
- White, light blue or navy blue polo, turtleneck (or mock turtleneck) or oxford button-up.
- Only plain white T-shirts may be worn under dress shirts - no designs. Long sleeves (white, light blue or navy blue) are permissible under short sleeves during cold weather only.

Jumpers:

- Girls in K-6 - hunter/navy classic plaid jumpers **must** be purchased from Educational Apparel or Land's End only.
- Shorts **MUST** be worn under jumpers.

Pants and Shorts:

- K-6 - navy blue uniform pants may be purchased from Educational Apparel, Land's End or other local retailers (i.e. Wal-Mart, Target, Old Navy). Pants with elastic waists are permissible.
- K-6 - navy blue walking shorts may be purchased from Educational Apparel, Land's End or other local retailers i.e. Wal-Mart, Target, Old Navy) and may be worn between August-October 15 and April 15-June.
- Shorts must be no shorter than 2" above the knee.
- Pants and shorts must fit well. Pants and shorts with belt loops are optional, however, **belts must be worn at all times if the pants have loops.**

Sweaters and Fleeces/Sweatshirts:

- Any type of UNIFORM sweater in navy, white, green, or gray (cardigan, crew neck, v-neck) may be worn, preferably with the keys logo embroidered on the left chest panel.
- Only navy fleece from Land's End with the keys logo embroidered on the left chest panel. These are to be worn only during cold weather from October 15-April 15.
- Only gray sweatshirt with the plaid logo from Educational Apparel or Land's End. These are to be worn only during cold weather from October 15-April 15.

Shoes & Socks/Leggings

- All students must wear socks; solid white, black, dark green, gray or navy.
- Leggings are permitted under jumpers only and must be white, navy blue, hunter green or black.
- Closed dress shoes in solid navy, black, or brown are preferable. Athletic shoes may be worn but must be a SOLID black, white, navy, brown or gray.
- No dress shoes with heels/wedges.
- Western boots will be permitted only in cold weather.

Jewelry:

- Small stud earrings may be worn by girls with no more than one earring per ear. Boys are NOT permitted to wear earrings.
- No facial jewelry or dangling earrings.
- Both girls and boys are not permitted to wear bracelets or necklaces.

Masks:

- School appropriate masks are to be worn to school daily for K-6 students.
- Cloth masks must be double ply
